Mpox (caused by the monkeypox virus) is an infection that is transmitted through close personal contact, including kissing, sex, and other skin-to-skin contact with a person who has mpox.





Rash often begins on the face and spreads over the body, extending to the palms of the hands and soles of the feet. It can also start on other parts of the body where contact was made, such as the genitals. It starts as a flat sore, which develops into a blister filled with liquid that may be itchy or painful.

Other Symptoms:



<u>If you develop symptoms:</u> isolate at home & contact a healthcare provider to get tested. <u>If you are diagnosed with mpox:</u> inform close contacts.
