## What is Cycchlorphine?

### N-PROPIONITRILE CHLORPHINE

- Cycchlorphine is a non-fentanyl synthetic opioid
- Found in the TN street drug supply with several reports in the Tennessee/Knoxville region
- Often found in combination with other substances including meth, benzos, xylazine, fentanyl and its analogues
- Lab data show this drug to be much stronger than fentanyl (10x)
- Has been detected in multiple fatal overdoses in Tennessee over the last 6 months
- Sensations reported to be similar to nitazenes ("zenes")

# CYCHLORPHINE

## Risks With Cycchlorphine

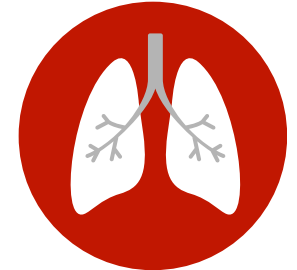
- Severe respiratory depression
  - Dangerously low breathing
  - Slowed heart rate
- Heavy sedation
- Increased the chance of overdose death

## Overdose Prevention

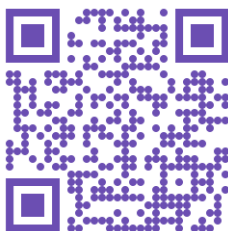
- Go slow & do not use alone
- Carry naloxone & know how to use it
- Start rescue breathing right away
- Use drug checking strips to test for fentanyl and xylazine



## Overdose Response

- ❑ Check for responsiveness
  - Shake & call out to the person
  - Perform a center chest rub
- ❑ Check for breathing
- ❑ Give naloxone every 2-3 mins until they are breathing
- ❑ Call 911 & stay with them
- ❑ Start rescue breathing
